Emergency Service:

We will reimburse **You** for emergency service labor charges up to a maximum of fifty dollars (\$50) per occurrence. These charges only apply to labor performed at the scene that is required to rectify situations involving **Your Vehicle**, such as the following: out of gas or battery discharged.



Pickup:

When a **Breakdown** occurs and makes **Your Vehicle** inoperable, **We** will reimburse **You** for **Your** actual incurred pickup cost up to a maximum of fifty dollars (\$50) per occurrence.



Transferable:

The **Vehicle Service Contract** may be transferred to a new owner when the simple guidelines, outlined in the **Vehicle Service Contract**, are met.



Warranty Deductible Paid:

Subject to the **Vehicle Service Contract Deductible**, **We** will pay **You**, up to one hundred dollars (\$100), for the **Deductible** paid on factory warranty repairs only when the repairs performed are due to a covered failure of a listed part under this **Vehicle Service Contract**.



Emergency Travel Expense Reimbursement:

Payable when **Your Vehicle** listed in Part I (Proof of Registration) has a **Mechanical Breakdown** 100 miles or more from **Your** primary residence. **You** are then eligible to qualify for reimbursement up to five hundred dollars (\$500) maximum for emergency travel expenses to return to **Your** residence or destination and return to pick up **Your Vehicle** after repair. Emergency travel expenses include commercial lodging and meals (incurred in the vicinity of where the **Breakdown** occurred) and rental of a replacement vehicle obtained from a licensed car rental agency or the repair facility, substantiated with verifiable receipts. Lodging and meals are limited to one hundred dollars (\$100) per day for 5 days, not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) per occurrence.

Travel the Trails with Confidence

MasterTech Elite Snowmobile coverage is stated **Component Coverage** which means it will cover the parts listed below with the exceptions listed in the sections titled “Noncovered Parts and Services” and “Noncovered Conditions.”



Engine: All internally lubricated parts including: Camshaft and bearings; connecting rods and bearings; crankshaft and main bearings; reed blocks and internal reed valves (where fitted); oil pump; pushrods and lifters; pistons, piston rings, and pins; rocker arms; shafts and bushings; timing gears, chains, and/or belts; transfer port valves, valve springs, guides, and seats; engine mounts; manifolds; valve covers. Engine head(s), engine block, and cylinder barrels are covered only if damage is a result of a **Breakdown** of a covered engine part.



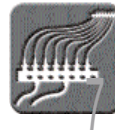
Lubricating System: Complete oil injection system, oil injection pump, injection metering system, oil injection drive gear, oil tank, oil level sensor, and oil lines.



Steering: Inner and outer tie rod ends, drag link and steering link ends, and spindle bushing.



Fuel System: Fuel tank, fuel pump, petcock, fuel injection metering system, choke cable(s), fuel injectors, lines, and fittings.



Electrical: Alternator, coils, magneto, manually-operated switches, rectifiers, rotors, rotor assembly, ignition coils, electronic fuel injection and control module, starter (electric only), solenoids, stators, voltage regulator, relays, wiring harness, and ignition modulator or CDI unit.



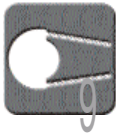
Primary Drive: Stationary and moveable sheaves, spider, outer cap, and bushings.



Secondary Drive: Stationary and moveable sheaves, spider, cam assembly, secondary (jack) shaft, and bearings.



Gauges & Controls: Fuel gauge, speedometer, tachometer, temperature gauge, amp gauge, oil gauge, starter/choke primer switch, run/stop switch, throttle control handle, throttle cable, and ignition switch (excluding key and tumbler).



Chain Case: All internally lubricated parts within chain case including: upper and lower chain sprocket, automatic and manually adjusted tensioners, roller chain, silent chain, chain case, reverse gear, and gear box (excluding shifter mechanism).



Brake Components: Disc, mechanical calipers, hydraulic calipers, master cylinder, and brake hoses.



Seals & Gaskets: For **Covered Components** (new units only).

Brake Components: Master cylinder, hydraulic brake actuator, and backing plate.

Frame Components: Axle(s) brackets, bunks, couplers, hubs, roller cradles, spring hangers, and winch stand.
